FEES AND CHARGES TO REVIEW OF SECURITY PROGRAMMES AND TRAINING MANUALS

The GCAA has adopted the following fees and charges for reviewing stakeholders' Aviation Security Programmes and Training Programmes commencing in the latter half of 2012.

Stakeholders, once operating at the CJIA or OAI and/or providing aviation security training, are required to provide to the Authority, a copy of their Aviation Security Programme and/or Training Manual for review and approval. This process is to ensure that stakeholders complies with the requirements of the National Civil Aviation Security Programme and the Aviation (Security) Regulations of 2004.

Fees for the review and approval of the submissions of Aviation Security (AVSEC) Programmes and AVSEC Training Manuals are stipulated in the table below:

1. International Airports	G\$30,000
2. Domestic Aerodromes	G\$15,000
3. Large Aircraft Operations (Pax & Cargo)	G\$25,000
4. Small Aircraft Operations (Pax & Cargo)	G\$15,000
5. Large Aircraft Operations (All Cargo)	G\$25,000
6. Small Aircraft Operations (All Cargo)	G\$15,000
7. Cargo Companies/Handlers	G\$15,000
8. Catering Services/Providers	G\$12,000
9. Ground Handling Companies	G\$15,000
10. Air Navigation Service Provider	G\$15,000
11. AVSEC Training Service Provider	G\$15,000

NB. The issuing of Certificate of Approvals is based on the successful evaluation of the Aviation Security Programmes and/or Training Manuals submitted to the Authority. During the review process, the Authority reserves the right to require that additional information be produced/submitted by stakeholders or amendments be made to the submissions before an approval is granted.
