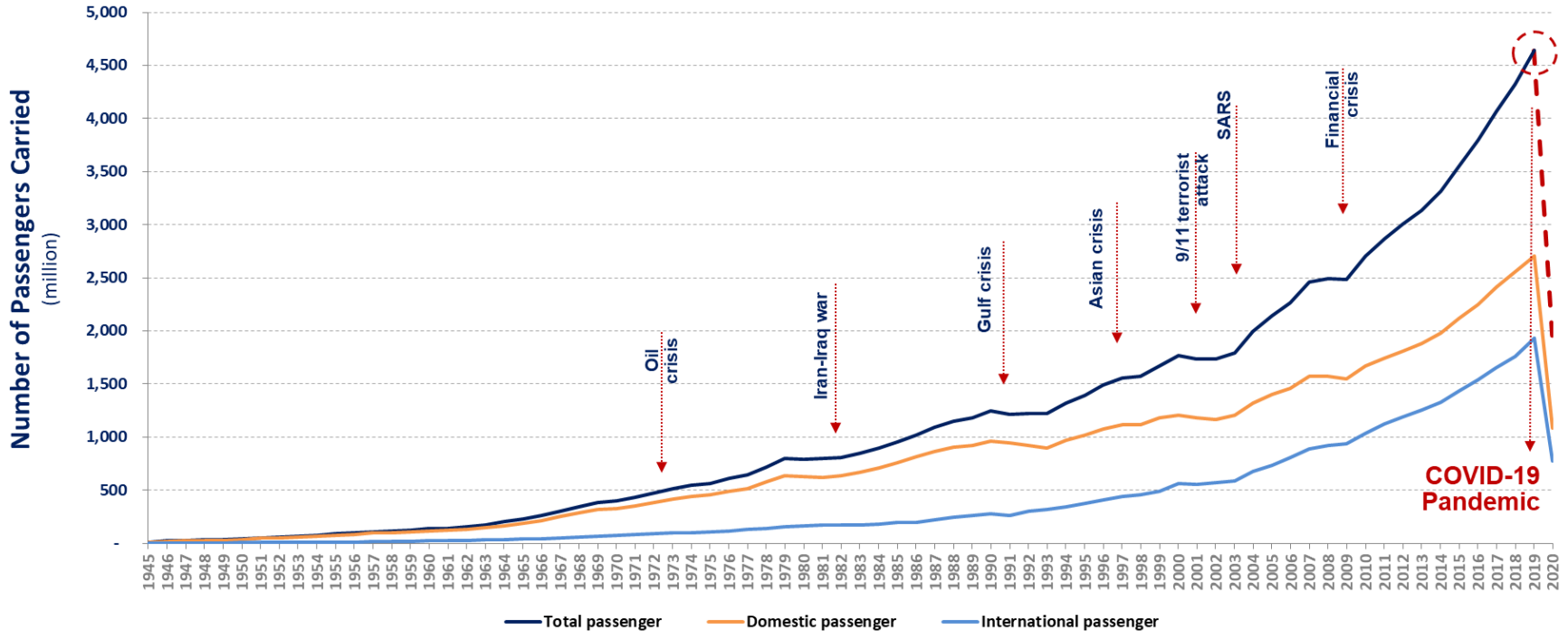

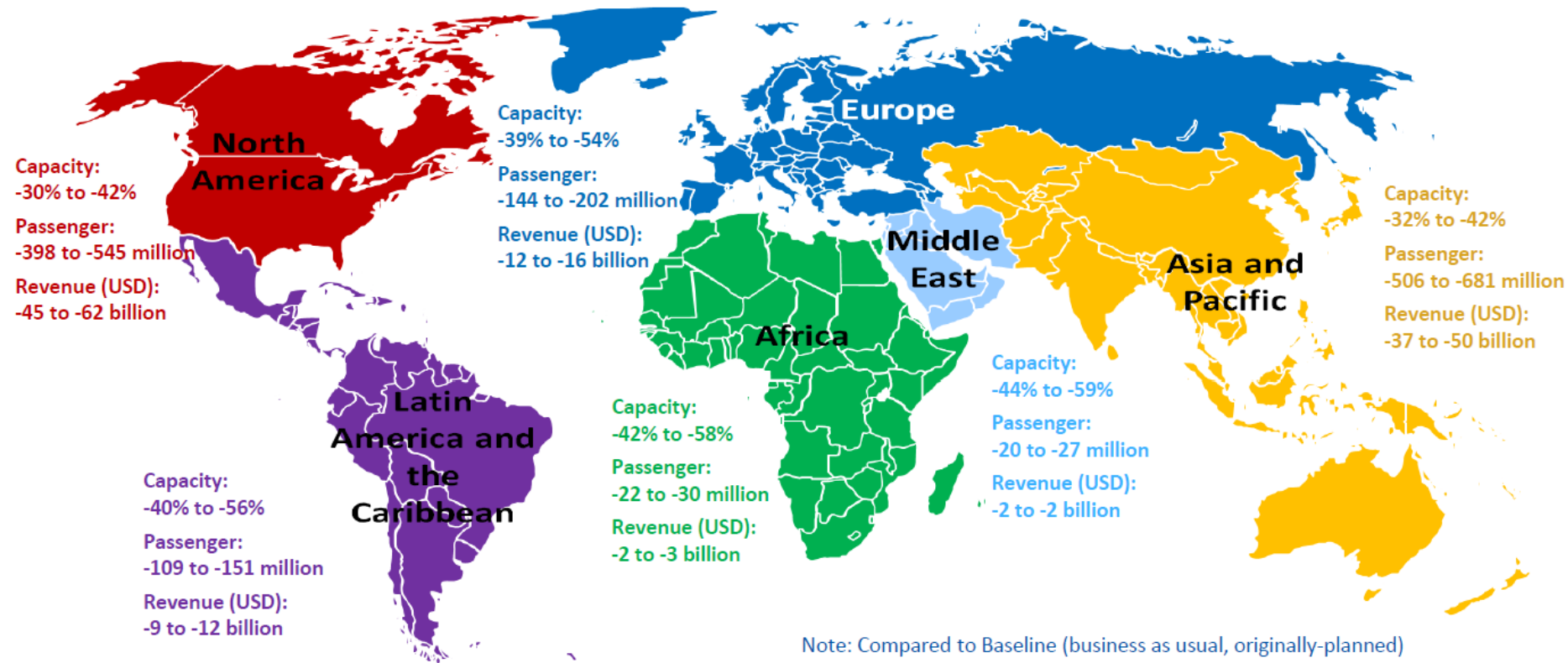

Outcomes on Initial response

- Coordinated and harmonized aeronautical publications
- Guidelines on risk assessments for extension of licenses and certificates
- Contingency reporting of differences
- Humanitarian and repatriation flights facilitation

Outcomes on Restart and Recovery

- Regional reference for Sanitary Protocols
- Guidelines for restart on risk mitigation for Operations, Airworthiness and Licenses
- AVSEC Sanitary guidelines and full America's coordination
- Airport restart checklist
- Communications Plan in place



Way forward

- SAM observes **gradual increase** (Brazil, Chile) and **restart** (Ecuador, Bolivia) of operations
- Domestic, Regional and International flights most likely will have **different phases** of restart prevalence
- Use of reference **harmonized protocols** is essential: transparency and communication will avoid unnecessary additional burden to the passengers and the system overall
- Moving from grounded operations to a restart demands **robust change management** approach
- Resilience of the system depends on **timely policies and the effective adoption of operational, financial, sanitary and communication** measures
