Aerodromes Inspector - Trainee

Suitably qualified persons are invited to apply for the position of **Aerodromes Inspector-Trainee** in the Aviation Safety and Security Directorate.

ROLE

To provide and maintain efficient and effective safety oversight for the regulated aerodromes in Guyana, as delegated, with the objective of enhancing the safety, efficiency and regularity of air navigation in Guyana airspace, through scheduled and unscheduled inspections of all aerodromes, aerodrome facilities, equipment, manuals, and personnel, and the review of all other documentation, both used and generated by the aerodrome operators, thus ensuring their compliance with the applicable Civil Aviation Regulations.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Bachelor's Degree in aeronautical/mechanical/electrical/civil engineering.
- OR,**
- Holder of an Aviation License (Commercial Pilot, Air Traffic Controller, Aircraft Maintenance Engineer) and three (3) years' experience.

SPECIFIC KNOWLEDGE REQUIRED

The ability to concentrate on the work at hand and to pay attention to detail.

- A well-developed understanding of, and a healthy respect for, the value of time.
- A disciplined, systematic, and methodical approach to carrying out each task.
- The ability to communicate effectively at all levels and in both oral and written formats.

- The ability to exercise sound, professional judgement at all times, even when under pressure.
- Ability to work effectively in a multi-disciplinary team environment.
- Integrity, impartiality, tact, and a good understanding of human nature, are all essential.

SPECIALIZED SKILLS/ATTRIBUTES

- Excellent human relations skill,
- Sound administrative skills.
- Ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing
- Ability to apply sound reasoning and to display good judgement.
- Proficiency in the use of computers and the relevant software

WORKING HOURS

- Based at Head Office but required to work most of the time at aerodromes and at operator's facilities, carrying out inspections, audits, investigations and general surveillance.
- Normally required to work weekdays 8:00 am to 4:40 pm but may be required to work outside of these days/hours at times when carrying out surveillance activities and investigations.
- Will be required from time to time to travel to training facilities overseas for specialized training.
