## **JOB SPECIFICATION**

#### **ROLE**

Provide regulatory safety oversight through inspections, audits, examinations and other certification and surveillance functions for the maintenance activities of all aircraft operators and Approved Maintenance Organizations in Guyana, and all Guyana air operators and Guyana aircraft operating outside of Guyana. Also, provide regulatory safety oversight functions for all persons engaged in providing aircraft maintenance services in Guyana and for Guyana's aircraft both locally and overseas, as per the Guyana Civil Aviation Regulations and requirements.

### **QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE**

#### **Essential:**

- Holder of a type-rated Aircraft Maintenance Engineer's Licence who has exercised the privileges of such Licence for at least eight (8) years;
- At least five (5) years' experience in a managerial or senior supervisory position in an Approved Maintenance Organization, or an Air Operator's aircraft maintenance department.

#### Desirable:

- A Diploma or Degree in Management or an Aviation-related field from a recognized University would be an asset.
- Quality Control and Assurance for Airworthiness and Maintenance will be an asset.
- Safety Management System (SMS) will be an asset.
- Familiarity with processing MORs, manual amendments, Service Bulletin, Airworthiness Directives, Release to Service, etc. will be an asset.

## SPECIFIC KNOWLEDGE REQUIRED

- Working knowledge of the Guyana Civil Aviation Act and Regulations.
- Working knowledge of the relevant ICAO Annexes (1, 5, 6, 7, 8, 13, 16 & 19).

- Will be required from time to time to travel to training facilities overseas for formal and specialized training or for carrying out various surveillance, certification, or investigation functions.
