**SUBJECT: IMPLEMENTATION OF NEWLY
PROMULGATED REGULATIONS
AND REQUIREMENTS**

DIRECTIVE

1) AUTHORITY

In accordance with the Requirements prescribed by the Authority under Section 142 Minister under Section 140 of the Civil Aviation Act 2018 as amended by the Civil Aviation (Amendment) Act 2024, and of the said Act, and pursuant to the authority vested under Section 142 (1) (b) of the Act, the following Directive is issued to facilitate the orderly implementation of the newly promulgated **Regulations and Requirements (2024)**.

2) PURPOSE

This **DIRECTIVE** serves to provide a structured timeline and process for the aviation industry to comply with the newly promulgated regulations and requirements.

3) APPLICABILITY

This **DIRECTIVE** is applicable to all **AVIATION DOCUMENT HOLDERS, AIR TRAFFIC SERVICES** and all relevant stakeholders operating under the jurisdiction of the Guyana Civil Aviation Authority.

4) VALIDITY:

This **DIRECTIVE** is effective from the 16th day of May 2024 and remains in effect until the 15th day of November 2024.

5) DIRECTIVE:

The Civil Aviation Regulations 2024 and Civil Aviation Requirements 2024 are in effect immediately. However, a transition period of six (6) months from the date of this Directive is granted for the implementation of any new provisions of the recently promulgated Civil Aviation Regulations and Requirements 2024.

All affected entities must achieve full compliance by the **15th day of November 2024**.

6) COMPLIANCE AND REPORTING:


1. All Operators shall submit a compliance plan within one (1) month of the date of this Directive, outlining their strategy for implementing new Regulations and Requirements.
2. All Operators shall submit a monthly progress report to the Guyana Civil Aviation Authority during the transition period.
3. Full compliance shall be achieved by the implementation deadline, and a final compliance report shall be submitted no later than the 15th day of November 2024.


7) SUPPORT AND ASSISTANCE:

The Guyana Civil Aviation Authority will provide support and guidance to assist Operators in achieving compliance, which may include technical assistance and clarification of the new Regulations and Requirements.

8) ENFORCEMENT

Failure to comply with the new Regulations and Requirements by the end of the transition period may result in enforcement action as is stipulated under the Act and Regulations, including but not limited to suspension of aviation document and/or operations, or other appropriate measure.
