PUBLIC NOTICE- Updated Oct. 1, 2020

The General Public is hereby notified that Guyanese who are stranded abroad must meet the following requirements to be repatriated on the next available flight to Guyana:

Step 1

Do a molecular biological PCR test for COVID-19.

Step 2

Submit a scanned copy or a clear photograph of the PCR test result and the completed electronic Repatriation Form. The form can be accessed on the Ministry of Foreign Affairs' website ***minfor.gov.gy*** and the GCAA's website ***gcaa-gy.org***.

NB. PCR test result must not be older than seven (7) days from the time the sample was taken. Passengers are urged to self isolate after taking the PCR test and await the result.

All passengers must present their PCR test result to the Airline Staff at the time of boarding the aircraft.
